

The last single released was a double A side featuring 'Maybe

I'm In Love' and a cover of the Beatles track 'Yesterday'. It was released on 4th August 1997 and went straight into the UK charts at number 4. There were 3 formats available - the cassette (cat no. JWLMC31) featured Yesterday & Maybe I'm in Love. Cd1 (cat no. JWLCD31) included Yesterday, Maybe I'm In Love, Goodnight Girl '94 and a beautiful Acoustic version of Yesterday.

Cd2 (cat no. JWLDD31) features Maybe I'm In Love, Yesterday and Live versions of Beyond The Sea & Love Is All Around which were both recorded at the ISDN session in March '97. Yesterday was also featured on the soundtrack to the hugely successful Mr Bean movie which was also released this year.

It was tour time again & the band were really geared up and raring to go. They were all really eager to get back out on stage again as they were in the studio recording '10' during 1996, they had all really missed performing live. The last time that Wet Wet Wet were on stage in the UK was during their hugely successful 'Picture This Tour' in 1995 when they played to over 550,000 people making the Wets one of the biggest live acts ever.

Unfortunately although ticket sales were good for the three scheduled stadium shows, (Milton Keynes National Bowl, Don Valley Sheffield Arena & Glasgow Celtic Park) it seemed that there was some resistance to the idea of Stadium shows therefore the band decided to move the gig indoors and re-schedule them as follows:-

GLASGOW CELTIC PARK.....7th SEPTEMBER

BIRMINGHAM NEC ARENA10th SEPTEMBER

Although we were all stunned by the tragic news of the death of Diana, Princess Of Wales the consensus of the hundreds of fans who called the Birmingham NEC was that the concert should go ahead as planned. The band held a minute silence before the concert Marti then dedicated With a little help from my friends as a mark of respect for such a unique woman.

The band also decided to postpone their concert at Celtic Park on Saturday 6th September, as it fell on the same day as the funeral of Diana, Princess Of Wales.

The concert took place on Sunday 7th September. Unfortunately this also meant that the concert on Monday 8th September at the Birmingham NEC could not take place as scheduled as it would be impossible for the crew to dismantle the stage at Celtic Park and transport it to Birmingham in a day! The last show of the tour went

ahead on Wednesday 10th September. The band were really pleased with how each show went, the Celtic Park show was particularly challenging for the band as they were playing to 40,000 people in their home town. The first support act on stage was Scottish singer & ex Deacon Blue frontman, Ricky Ross, he was followed by a new up and coming band, My Life Story, who supported the Wets for their hold tour. The final support act was former Take That heartthrob Mark Owen. Wet Wet Wet then burst on to the stage with electric explosions and earth shattering screams from the crowd who were finally watching the band they had come to see. Sweet Little Mystery started the explosive set, they played all the old favourites, Wishing I Was Lucky, I Can Give You Everything, With A Little Help From My Friends and many more of their hits from the last 10 years. With this tour the band had a chance to play their new tracks from '10' to a live crowd for the first time and judging by everyone's reaction they went down a storm!! If I Never See You Again, the first track released from 10, finished their stunning set.

When the Wets came back on for their encore, they dazzled everyone as they performed their two 'big band' numbers, Beyond the Sea and Maybe I'm In Love, accompanied by spectacular lights and lasers, it really had to be seen to be believed. Marti's voice sailed round Celtic Park as the band left the stage for a second time and it left the crowd screaming for more.

'Do You Want More?' flashed upon the screens, 'Yes', was the overwhelming response from the 35,000 fans,

'When?....Today?....Now?......Yesterday?'. On this note the band launched into their most recent hit, the cover of the Beatles classic, 'Yesterday'. The band's biggest hit to date closed the show,'Love Is All Around' filled the air as everyone joined in to singalong, what a fantastic end to a fantastic night. Fireworks lit up the dark Glasgow sky as the band left the stage for the final time.
